UT Students will be here every Wednesday to help you practice your conversation skills. This won't cost you anything extra except for your time! Come practice your English conversation skills!



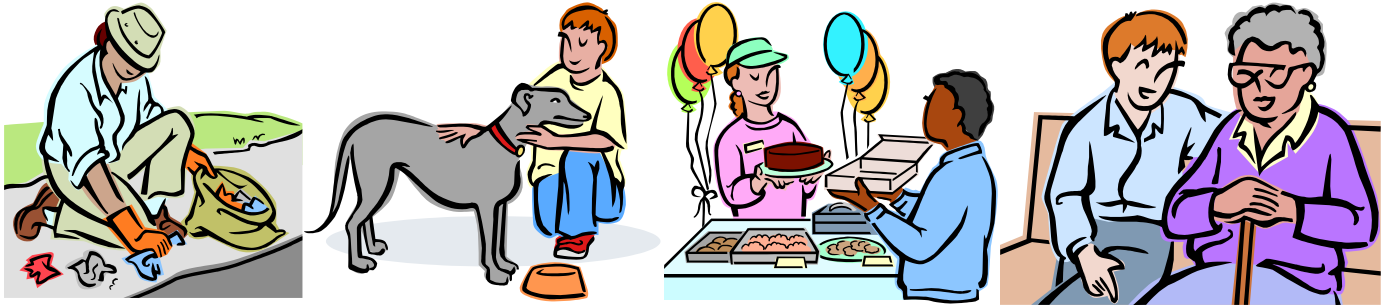
